All students enrolled in the Massage Therapy program must be in good general health, produce a 'negative' (clear) vulnerable sector check. Individuals considering a career as a Massage Therapist should enjoy working with people, be compassionate, patient and possess the ability to listen, as well as being physically able to assist in patient support.
