## **Personal Support Worker**



Admission requirements: Canadian High School Graduation Diploma or Mature Student Status (Mature students from Ontario must be at least 18 years of age by the program start date and successfully pass an academic achievement test. Mature students from other Canadian provinces must be at least 19 years of age and a minimum of 1 year out of high school by the program start date and successfully pass an academic achievement test). Please contact us for more detail regarding admissions requirements for international students. Ontario Secondary School Diploma or equivalent, or if none an academic achievement test must be passed; must pass clear police check including a clear Vulnerable Sector check; a clear medical certificate indicating current immunization and free from communicable diseases; successful completion of a technical literacy examination; and an admissions interview to determine suitability for a career as a Personal Support Worker.
