Purpose

As an educational institution, the College has developed policies and procedures which all individuals associated with the College are required to follow. Our policies and procedures provide a framework for consistent decision-making and provide guidance to ensure our actions are in alignment with our Mission, Vision, and Values.

Scope

This policy applies to all College students, employees, delivery partners, affiliates, and contractors.

Definitions

College: The broader corporate entity that encompasses all business units (triOS, Eastern, Lifecycle Systems, *etc.*) and all policies and procedures apply equally to them under this Executive Policy.

POLICY

- 1) The College shall develop a policy framework to ensure all members are treated in a fair and equitable manner in alignment with our Values.
- 2) The framework will encompass policies and procedures related to **People, Academics, Corporate activities**, and this Executive policy (P.A.C.E. framework)
- 3) College policies will be written in the style of this policy, and will typically include:
 - a) Purpose
 - b) Scope
 - c) Definitions
 - d) Policy Statement
 - e) Related Policies
 - f) Supporting Documents/Forms
- 4) The College will establish and maintain a Policy and Procedure Committee to be responsible for reviewing, updating, and communicating the College's policies and procedures. The Committee shall meet on a routine basis and is comprised of the following members:
 - a) The Executive Vice-President
 - b) The Vice President, Academic

- c) The Director of Finance
 - d) The Manager of Financial Aid & Compliance
 - e) A Regional Director of Operations
- 5) A recorder will be provided by the Committee to ensure Committee meeting minutes and decisions are documented.
